
Take Action for Reconciliation





Welcome to Take Action for Reconciliation

Take Action for Reconciliation explores reconciliation and ways that all Canadians can start on the pathway to reconciliation. Students can have a big impact on the world around them. They can use their voice to make their communities more respectful and fair!



Take Action for Reconciliation is an inquiry-based resource for Grade 3-8 that provides structured learning opportunities for teachers and students to delve deep into authentic learning relating to First Nations, Inuit, and Métis peoples historically and in contemporary Canada. Each section covers a different topic at a different grade level band.

Take Action for Reconciliation is designed to incorporate exploratory learning through the deconstruction and reconstruction of a topic. Both students' and teachers' understanding of the topic evolves by exposure to multiple perspectives and points of view. Through exploratory learning, teachers are encouraged to provide multiple opportunities for students to generate their own questions for further investigation and reflection, and connect the underlying themes to current local and national issues. **Physical Kits:** The DLC has 4 kits in English and 4 kits in French from the *Take Action for Reconciliation* series. Each kit has 16 copies of the student book and 1 teacher's guide.
